

Tax Payment

After your work permit has been arranged, the next step is for University to apply for Thai taxpayer identification card within 60 days after receiving income. You will need a Tax ID card in order to pay tax on your income.

- 1. Completed Form L.P. 10.1
- 2. Copy of Work Permit
- 3. Copy of passport and copy of arrival/departure card TM.6 (back and front)
- 4. House registration of University
- 5. Power of Attorney with 10 Baht duty stamp affixed and a copy of appointee's I.D. card (If the applicant is unable to apply in person).
