University Mobility in Asia and the Pacific

Dear UMAP Member Institutions and National Secretariats:

Warm greetings from Vancouver, Canada, where summer has arrived, bringing sunshine and bright flowers! As the new UMAP International Secretariat, we would like to occasionally share program news and updates – we plan to send this new newsletter out every few months. Although we are still prevented from traveling and studying in person, the UMAP network is busy developing opportunities for virtual engagement. We thrilled to present some of them below. UMAP COIL Honours Program

Applications are now open for the UMAP COIL Honours Program: *Learning Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Collaboratively*.

In this seven-week online program, students will learn about the SDGs adopted by the United Nations. Through this process, the course will explore the concept of global citizenship and what actions can lead to the development of global human resources which play an active role in a changing

world. Students will work together in small groups to in project-based work, make a group presentation and participate in lectures from experts from around the world.

This program is led by IIGE/Kansai University and co-sponsored by UMAP. Over 100 students from around the world are anticipated to participate in this program. Students from Australia, Brunei, Canada, Chile, China, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mexico, the Philippines, Taiwan, and Thailand can request applications and apply through the National Secretariats in those countries. Students from other UMAP countries can request applications and apply through the International Secretariat. Please refer to [this page](#) for more program information and to confirm the relevant contact information for your country. Students should submit their applications no later than **July 1, 2021** and participating National Secretariats will need to forward their student applications to IIGE/Kansai University by **July 5**. There is no cost to participate for UMAP member institution students.

Thailand's Micro-Credential Pilot Program now open for applications!

UMAP Thailand is rolling out their new online Micro-Credential Pilot Program. Applications are now being accepted for the first cohort of Strand A students, who will participate in a professional skills course on "Static Web Page for Data Displaying in Industrial Application." Please note that applicants need to list the UMAP coordinator at their home institution and the coordinator will need to upload a nomination letter on behalf of the institution. The application deadline is **July 15, 2021 (1pm Thailand time)**. There is no cost to participate for UMAP member institution students, but there are limited spaces available.

USCO System to open in July 2021

After discussions at the May UMAP board meeting, it was decided to open the USCO system in July, to allow member institutions to prepare for the possibility of physical mobility starting from January 2022. Because of the late opening, there will only be one application cycle in USCO for this session. Institutions in countries where classes are taking place normally and travel is allowed will have the opportunity to present Program A/B offerings. All institutions and

applicants must understand that the system will be open only on a trial basis, assuming the possibility for greater mobility in the next six months. If global conditions get worse, instead of better, programs will have to be cancelled. The final decision on whether it is safe enough to proceed with physical mobility programs will need to be taken on a case-by-case basis by the affected institutions and individuals.

UMAP Member Survey and Final Report

Thank you to the many member institutions that completed our member survey in May. The responses and the information they contained were extraordinarily helpful to us. We made a presentation to the UMAP board last month based on this data and the conclusions that we drew from it. Many of you wrote to us and asked to receive a copy of the results as well. [This link](#) will take you to a copy of the report that we presented to the board. You will find that the first several slides provide a high-level summary of the data and our conclusions and recommendations. The following slides allow for a deeper analysis of the data. Based on the valuable information we received from this survey, the International Secretariat will soon be announcing a number of new initiatives, including a more comprehensive orientation to UMAP and the USCO system for new (and old!) members as well as some “match making” events to help members identify international partners within the network. Stay tuned for the next newsletter with details about these new developments!
