Greetings from Embassy of India, Bangkok!



The Embassy is pleased to inform that application is now open for 2024 Quad Fellowship. The Quad STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) Fellowships were awarded last year to 100 students/scholars from the four Quad countries to pursue higher education programmes in the US. The first batch of Quad Fellows commenced their courses in the US in Fall 2021 - they are a diverse and dynamic batch of scientists, technologists, engineers, and mathematicians equally represented across the four Quad countries. The Fellowships are supported by corporate donors, including US-based companies.

2. **This year, Quad STEM Fellowship's have been broadened to include candidates from the ten ASEAN countries** of Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, **Thailand**, and Vietnam **in addition** to candidates from the four Quad countries. This is another step taken by the Quad towards its commitment to deliver concrete benefits for the Indo-Pacific region.

3. Applications for the academic year 2024-2025 can be accessed now on the Quad Fellowship website and will close on **April 1, 2024, 5:00 PM ET**. The website has further information on the application process, requirements, and eligibility criteria.



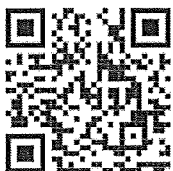

THE QUAD FELLOWSHIP BY IIE empowers exceptional engineering, mathematics, science, and technology graduate students studying in the U.S. to advance research and innovation with a lens of positive social impact throughout their careers by providing a unique combination of financial benefits, cross-cultural exchange, networking, and programming.

Eligibility Requirements

To apply, an applicant must:

- Be at least 18 years of age at the time of application
- Be a citizen or legal permanent resident of one of the **Quad countries**—Australia, India, Japan, or the United States—or any of the **10 ASEAN countries**—Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, or Vietnam
- Have a bachelor's degree or equivalent in a STEM field by August 2024
- Have a demonstrated record of superior academic achievement at the undergraduate level
- **Prospective Graduate students:** Must have already applied to an eligible STEM graduate program at a US-based university to begin the 2024-2025 academic year
- **Current Graduate students at US universities:** If applicants are currently enrolled in a Master's or PhD program, they must be enrolled in a qualified academic program during their time as a Fellow (i.e. August 2024–May 2025).
- Clinical healthcare degree programs such as doctorates of medicine or Masters of nursing are ineligible.

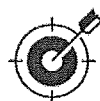

The Quad Fellowship is an initiative of the governments of Australia, India, Japan, and the United States. Announced by the Quad partners on September 24, 2021, this first-of-its-kind scholarship program is designed to build ties among the next generation of scientists and technologists. The Quad Fellowship is operated in consultation with a non-governmental task force composed of academic, foreign policy, and private sector leaders from each Quad country. Beginning in 2024, the fellowship will be administered by the Institute of International Education (IIE), a global not-for-profit organization that manages many of the world's most prestigious scholarship and fellowship programs.

The Quad Fellowship sponsors exceptional master's and doctoral students to study science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) in the United States. The fellowship supports students from the four Quad countries – Australia, India, Japan, and the United States and expands this year to include sponsorship of students from the ASEAN countries. The fellowship develops a network of science and technology experts committed to advancing innovation and collaboration in the private, public, and academic sectors, in their own nations and among Quad countries. The program builds foundational understanding among Quad Fellows of one another's societies and cultures through programming and networking opportunities with each country's top scientists, technologists, and politicians.

This can be demonstrated by research conducted, relevant coursework taken, internships held, extracurricular opportunities engaged, or professional indicators of commitment.

Curiosity, Compassion, and Integrity

Candidates should demonstrate an expansive and interdisciplinary sense of curiosity, an interest in building and sustaining genuine connections between individuals with differing cultural, socio-economic, and professional backgrounds, and exemplify integrity in both their professional and personal lives. This can be demonstrated through professional or personal experiences within and beyond the intersection of STEM and social impact.
