King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (**KMUTT**) is delighted to introduce the Thailand UMAP Micro Credential program which is aimed to fulfil the needs of learners who seek to upskill and reskill, develop needed specific competencies, or lifelong learning. The learners from this side will get a Certificate as a transcript to verify which Learning Outcome they have passed.

What is KMUTT Micro-Credential?

KMUTT Micro-Credential is a system that "verifies" and "enhances" an individual'sspecific competency using competency-based assessment. With this approach, an individualcan efficiently and clearly demonstrate their competencies by submitting evidence or worksamples according to the evaluation criteria. It is ideal for "Self-Learners" — those who areable to learn by themselves outside a classroom environment — who wish toevaluate their competency. Through micro-credentials, an individual can demonstrate theirvaluable competencies irrespective of how and where they are learnt. When an individual passes the evaluation criteria, they will earn a Digital Badge issued by KMUTT as a verification of their competency.

Characteristics of KMUTT Micro-Credentials



KMUTT emphasises the significance of competencies that are job-related or job-embedded. With feedback on real-work samples that demonstrate skills, experiences, and accomplishments, together with recommendations from experts, micro-credential earners can unleash their potential and improve themselves at their own pace.



Practical Levels of Competencies

KMUTT focuses on practical levels of competencies or those that can be used or applied in real-world situations. Each micro-credential requires an individual to demonstrate a skill, rather than a set of knowledge, through an evaluation of pieces of evidence that illustrate they can "Show-how" or "Dne"



Research-Backed

KMUTT micro-credentials are backed by research that illustrates how the methods can be used to successfully demonstrate the skills or how the competencies can enhance positive professional outcomes.



Transparency

KMUTT micro-credentials are transparent. Potential earners can read through every detail of the micro-credential and its submission criteria. Earners receive thorough feedback from the assessor.



Self-Pace

Individuals can take their time to work on their micro-oredential submission. With self-paced practice, individuals can determine their own learning and self-development experience at their own pace, according to their own needs and learning preferences.



Recognisable

Once an individual passes evaluation criteria, they receive a digital badge that verifies their competency. The digital badge can be shared with their network and recognised by potential employers. How the individual demonstrates their competency is securely stored in the digital badge, along with other metadata including the issuer, the evaluation criteria, and evidence.
