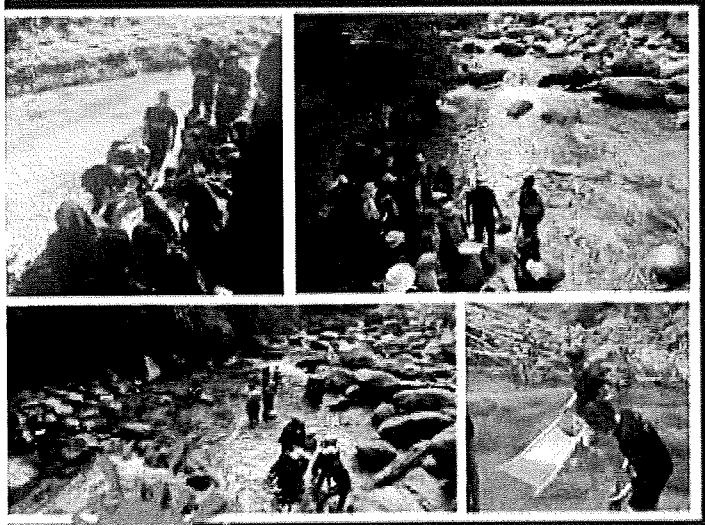
FIELDWORK *for the* ENTOMOPHILES ENTO-AWARE

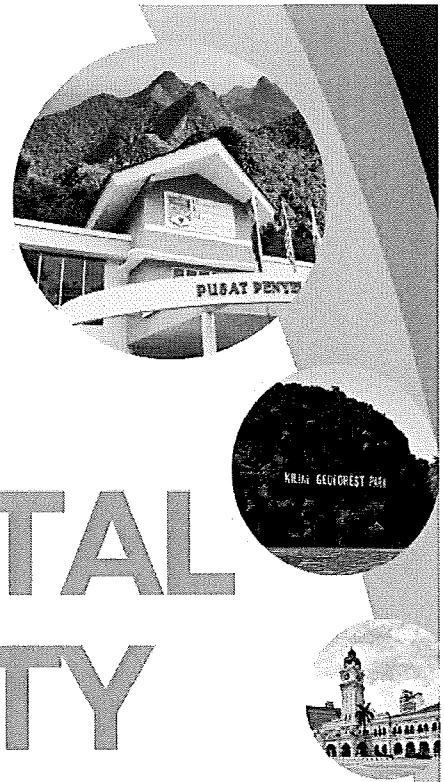
