MOBILITY EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

LONG-TERM EXCHANGE PROGRAMS

This program aims to encourage and increase mobility actions of students among overseas partner universities. Participating students are required to register and spend a semester at the host university. Neither the number of credits nor credit transfer is required under one of the following 4 channels: register in relevant courses of study, research or thesis, internship or professional training, or register in courses required by Dual/Double degree programs (outbound track only).

Inbound Program

Plan A: International students with full financial support (Tuition fee with other associated fees, on-campus dormitory, monthly allowance)

Plan B: Students with tuition fee waiver support

Post-doctoral Scholarships: Monthly allowances and accommodation for international post-doctoral researchers

Outbound Program

Naresuan University students who get accepted to spend a semester overseas will be supported with international airfare ticket of up to 30,000 THB

SHORT-TERM INTERCULTURAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

NU Cultural Exchange Program in Thailand

This 2-week cultural program offers for international students to learn various aspects of Thai culture in a variety of activities; including Thai Music, Thai Dance, Thai Cooking, Thai Boxing, Thai Massage, activities with NU Students, excursions, etc.

Outbound InterCultural Exchange Program

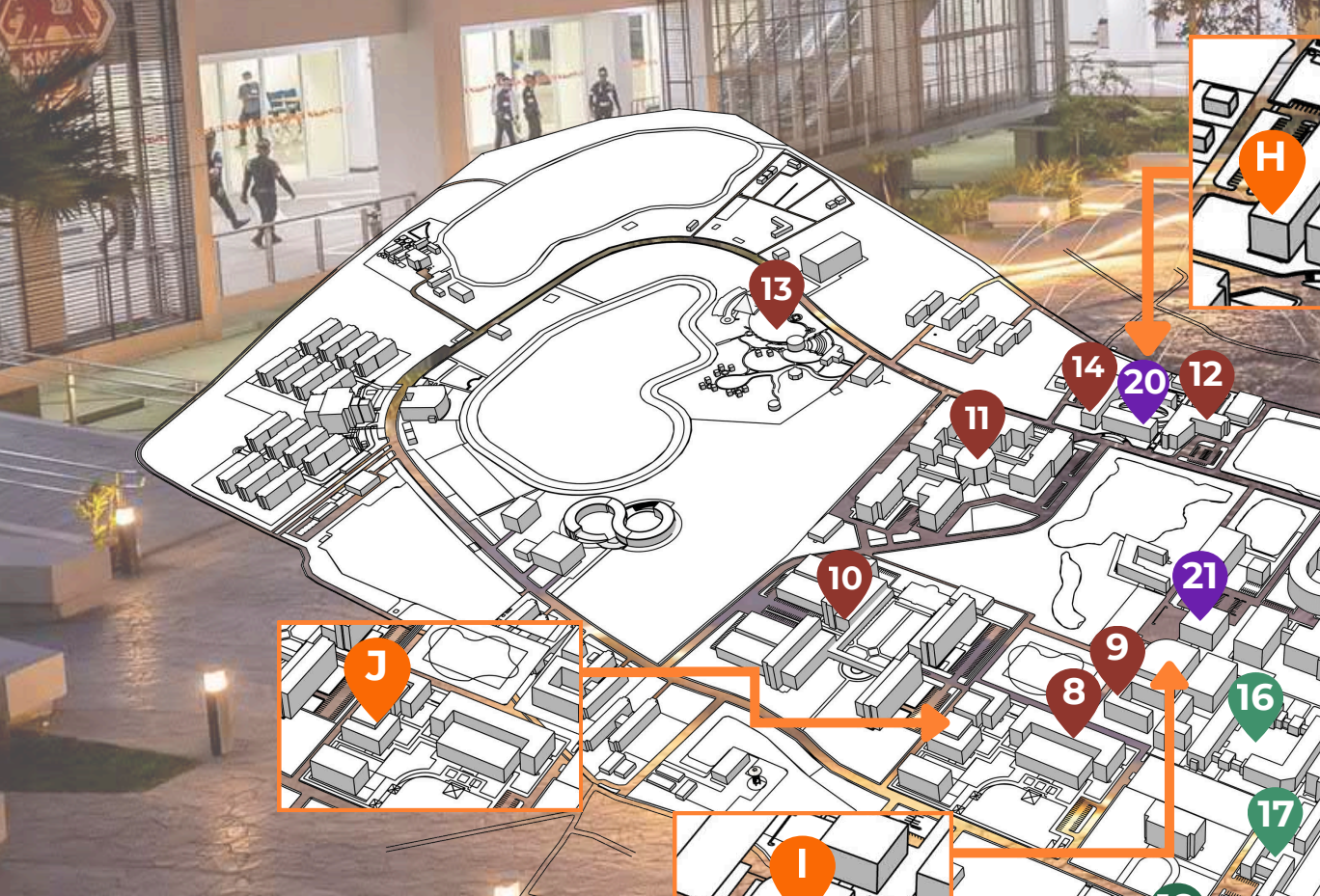

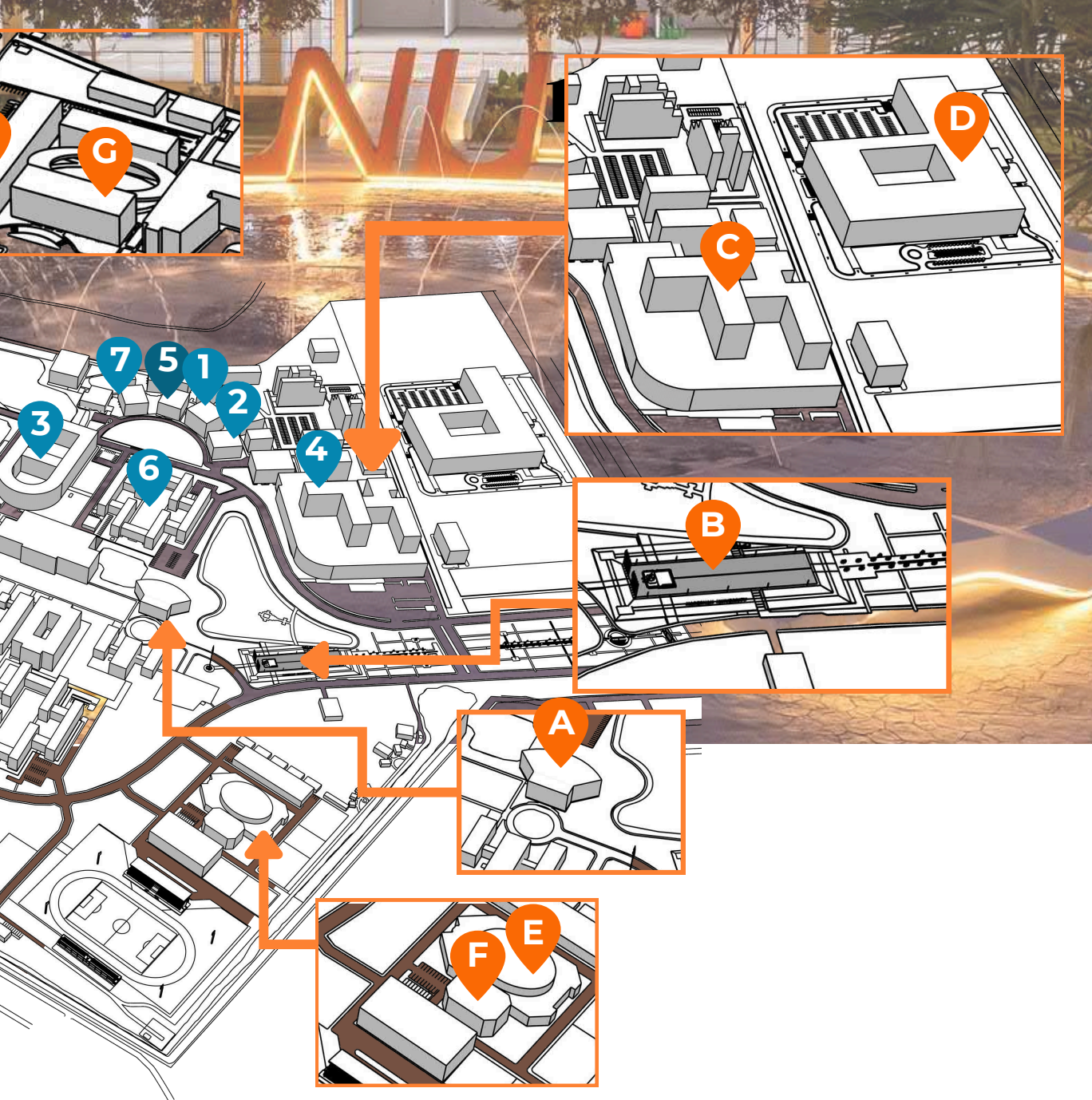
