Notes

1. Learners register in the course according to their CEPT latest scores (not later than two years).
2. After completing the course with the 'PASS' result, learners can be move up to the higher level.
3. Non-academic staff are required to pass the course EAD (Pre-Intermediate) and use the result as a replacement for CEPT examination.
4. Academic staff are required to pass the EAD (Upper-Intermediate) and use the result as a replacement for CEPT examination.
5. The activities and exercises are flexible as seen appropriate by the lecturer, but they need to be completed after the course is finished.
6. The essays need to be academic (i.e. introduction-body-conclusion form, one-page length, with references, etc.)
7. The lecturer can assign other exercises related to each unit as homework or self-study.
